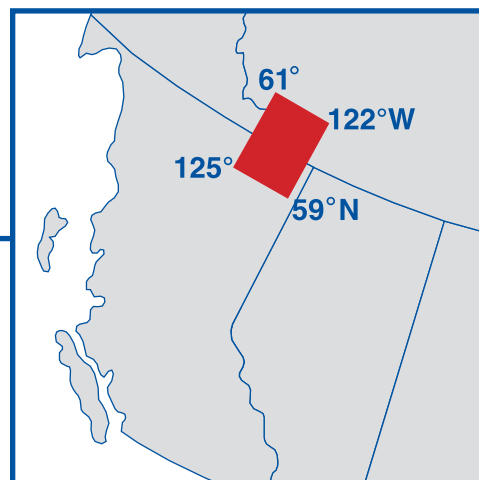


Cretaceous Chinkeh and Triassic Mattson Formations

59-61°N 122-125°W

The Liard Basin project was conducted in 2000 and updated in 2005. It examines the hydrocarbon producing potential of the Cretaceous Chinkeh and Triassic Mattson formations by evaluating their pressure and fluid distributions. These evaluations define the **reservoir continuities, permeabilities, entrapment types, potential position of their deep basin edges and by-passed wells.**

The evaluations are housed in a binder. It consists of separate technical documentation, data compilation and map suite. The maps include pool delineation maps, PIE graphs and fluid chemistry maps.
